



Catch up Funding 2017/18

The literacy and numeracy catch-up premium gives schools additional Funding to support year 7 pupils who did not achieve the 100 standardised score in reading and/or maths at the end of key stage 2.

In the academic year 2017/18 40 pupils are eligible for £500 Catch up Funding each. The Funding allocation is £20,000.

The objectives of the Funding are:

- To close the attainment gap by providing intensive literacy and numeracy support to students entitled to catch up Funding
- To enhance the existing provision
- To identify concerns and target intervention and support to accelerate progress
